Trotwood Man Found Guilty in Fatal Traffic Crash With Bicyclist

State v. Gregory H. Creech, 2016-CR-1342

DAYTON, OH (11/09/2016) – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that **Gregory H. Creech**, 60, of Trotwood, has been found guilty for causing the death of a bicyclist in a traffic crash on James H. McGee Boulevard on December 10, 2015.

On Thursday, December 10, 2015, the defendant was driving his SUV southbound on James H. McGee Boulevard near the intersection of Philadelphia Drive, in Dayton when he struck the victim's bicycle from behind. The victim was dragged by defendant's vehicle approximately 100 feet after the impact. The defendant was found to have cocaine, Fentanyl, and morphine in his system at the time of the crash.

On September 1, 2016, the defendant was indicted on counts of Aggravated Vehicular Homicide and OVI. Today, he was found guilty as charged on one count of Aggravated Vehicular Homicide and one count of misdemeanor OVI.

The defendant is in custody, being held on a \$250,000 bond. He will be sentenced on November 22, 2016, at 2:00 pm. He faces a mandatory driver's license suspension from 3 years to life, as well as a possible sentence of up to 5 years in prison.
