## **Dayton Man Indicted for Republic Drive Homicide**

*State v. Keyandre Danley, 2016-CR-2549*

**DAYTON, OH (08/25/2016)** – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that 19 year old **Key'andre Hombre Danley**, of Dayton, has been indicted for the shooting death of Darius Jones on August 8, 2016, in Harrison Township.

In the early morning hours of Monday, August 8, 2016, several 911 calls were made reporting that a person had been shot on Republic Drive in Harrison Township. First responders located the deceased body 19 year old Darius Lamar Jones, of Dayton. The victim had been shot several times.

Subsequent investigation determined that the defendant was the person who fired the fatal shots.

Today, the defendant was indicted on:

- Two counts of Murder
- Two counts of Felonious Assault
- Two counts of Having Weapons While Under Disability
- Two counts of Improperly Discharging a Firearm At or Into a Habitation
- One count of Tampering With Evidence

All of the counts, except for tampering with evidence and having weapons while under disability, include 3 year firearm specifications because the defendant used a firearm to commit the crimes.

The defendant is currently in custody, being held on a \$1,000,000 bond and will be arraigned on August 30, 2016 at 8:30 am.

The defendant also has a currently pending felony case, 2016-CR-2532, in which he was indicted for one count of Failure to Notify on August 19, 2016. The defendant is a Tier II Registered Sex Offender, because of an adjudication for Gross Sexual Imposition as a juvenile, and the defendant failed to notify the Sheriff's Office of his address, as required by law.
