Dayton Woman Indicted for Fatal Shooting

State v. Nina Davis, 2016-CR-2066

DAYTON, OH (07/08/2016) – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that 34 year old **Nina Mirjuana Davis**, of Dayton, has been indicted for fatally shooting Travis Smith, 34, on June 29, 2016.

On Wednesday, June 29, 2016, the defendant called 911, stating that the victim needed an ambulance because he had been shot. When police arrived, they located the deceased victim inside the bathroom of the Patton Avenue home he shared with the defendant and their four children. The victim had been shot one time with a .45 caliber handgun.

Subsequent investigation revealed that the defendant had shot the victim, apparently after an argument. Police located the weapon hidden inside a dresser drawer.

Today, the defendant was indicted on:

- Two counts Murder
- Two counts Felonious Assault
- One count of Tampering With Evidence

Both the murder and felonious assault counts include 3-year firearm specifications because the defendant used a firearm to commit the crime.

The defendant will be arraigned on July 12, 2016 at 8:30 am. She is currently in custody in the Montgomery County Jail, being held on a \$1,000,000 bond.
