Dayton Man Indicted for Murder

State v. Michael Felton, 2015-CR-1818

DAYTON, OH (7/13/2015) – Prosecutor Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that 24-year-old **Michael Antjuan Felton**, of Dayton, has been indicted on charges for the shooting death of 44-year-old **John Turner, Jr.**, also of Dayton.

On June 16, 2015, the victim and the defendant were in an altercation involving a female mutual acquaintance. During the altercation, the defendant produced a handgun and fatally shot the victim in the parking lot of a Norris Drive apartment complex. There were numerous witnesses to the shooting.

Today, the defendant has been indicted for:

- One count of Murder, as a result of committing felonious assault with a deadly weapon
- One count of Murder, as a result of committing felonious assault causing serious physical harm
- One count of Felonious Assault with a deadly weapon
- One count of Felonious Assault causing serious physical harm
- One count of Tampering With Evidence
- One count of Having Weapons While Under Disability

All of the murder and felonious assault counts include 3-year firearm specifications because the defendant used a firearm to commit the offenses. The defendant was barred from legally possessing a firearm because he was previously convicted in 2012 of burglary, which is an offense of violence. Additionally, in 2010 the defendant was convicted of carrying concealed weapons.

The defendant is currently in custody in the Montgomery County Jail on a \$100,000 bond. He is scheduled to be arraigned on July 16, 2015 at 8:30 a.m.
