Convicted Sex Offender Sentenced for Child Porn

State v. Stephen Foy, 2016-CR-0806

DAYTON, OH (5/25/2016) – Prosecutor Mat Heck, Jr. announced that 39-year-old **Stephen Foy**, of Union, has been sentenced for his convictions on counts of pandering obscenity involving a minor.

On Thursday, March 3, 2016, officers from Union and Englewood served a search warrant at the home of the defendant, after receiving information from the Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force that the defendant was sharing child pornography over the internet.

On March 21, 2016 the defendant was indicted on counts of Pandering Obscenity Involving Minor, a second degree felony.

On May 4, 2016, the defendant was found guilty as charged on two counts by the court.

Today, the defendant was sentenced to 8 years in the penitentiary.

The defendant was previously convicted of illegal use of a minor in nudity oriented material or performance, pandering obscenity involving a minor and gross sexual imposition. On April 6, 2011 the defendant was ordered to serve 18 months in prison and was designated a Tier III Sex Offender, which requires the defendant to register his address every 90 days for the rest of his life.

Prosecutor Heck added, “This is yet another defendant who clearly learned nothing from the time he spent in prison. We need to protect the children in our community from sex offenders, especially repeat sex offenders, such as this defendant.”
