Dayton Man Indicted for Manhattan Avenue Murder

State v. Anthony Gause, 2020-CR-1616

DAYTON, OH (06/08/2020) – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that **ANTHONY E. GAUSE**, 31, of Dayton, has been indicted for counts in connection to the shooting death of Jayven T.E. Kilgore on May 29, 2020.

During the morning hours of Friday, May 29, 2020, Dayton police were dispatched to a residence on Manhattan Avenue on a report of a shooting. Upon arrival they located the deceased victim, identified as Jayven Kilgore, 24, who had been shot once.

Witnesses described an altercation had taken place between the defendant and the victim. When the victim tried to run away, the defendant fired multiple shots, striking and killing the victim.

Today, the Montgomery County Grand Jury indicted the defendant for:

- Two counts of Murder
- Two counts of Felonious Assault
- One count of Discharge of a Firearm On or Near Prohibited Premises
- One count of Tampering With Evidence

All of the counts except for tampering with evidence include 3-year firearm specifications.

The defendant is currently in the Montgomery County Jail, being held on a \$1,000,000 bond. He will be arraigned on Thursday, June 11, 2020, at 8:30 a.m.
