Dayton Man Indicted for K-9 Club Homicide

State v. Dale Glenn, 2016-CR-0821

DAYTON, OH (03/18/2016) – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that 30 year old **Dale Anthony Glenn**, of Dayton, has been indicted for the shooting death of 29 year old Michael Mays-Belton.

During the early morning hours of Wednesday, March 9, 2016 an argument occurred between the victim and the defendant inside the K-9 Club at 5100 Germantown Pike in Jefferson Township. The defendant was removed from the club by security. When the victim exited the building, the defendant fatally shot the victim several times. The defendant then entered a vehicle and fled the scene.

Today, the Montgomery County Grand Jury has indicted the defendant on:

- One count Murder (purposeful)
- Two counts Murder (while committing felonious assault)
- Two counts Felonious Assault
- Two counts Having Weapons While Under Disability (prior drug conviction)

All of the counts, except for having weapons while under disability, have three-year firearm specifications attached.

The defendant is currently in custody in the Montgomery County Jail, being held on a \$1,000,000 bond. The defendant will be arraigned on March 22, 2016 at 8:30 a.m.
