Teen Indicted for Riverside Carjacking

State v. Maverick Hamblin, 2021-CR-2156

DAYTON, OH (07/20/2021) – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that **MAVERICK M. HAMBLIN**, 17, of Dayton, has been indicted for counts related to a carjacking that occurred in Riverside on March 22, 2021.

On the evening of Monday, March 22, 2021, Riverside police officers were dispatched on a report of an armed robbery in the parking lot of the Airway Baptist Church at 4658 Airway Road. Upon arrival, the victims described a suspect who had pointed a gun at them as they were seated in a vehicle. The victims were ordered out of the vehicle and told to lay on the ground. The defendant took their cellphones and drove away in the victims' vehicle.

Further investigation identified the defendant as the perpetrator. Due to the serious nature of the offenses and the defendant's age and prior adjudications, a motion was filed to transfer the defendant to be tried as an adult. The Juvenile Court judge granted the motion.

Today, the Montgomery County Grand Jury indicted the defendant for:

- Two counts of Aggravated Robbery with a deadly weapon

Both counts have 3-year firearm specifications.

The defendant is currently in custody in the Montgomery County Juvenile Justice Detention Center. He is scheduled to be arraigned on Thursday, July 22, 2021 at 8:30 a.m.
