**Mother's Boyfriend Indicted for Causing Death of 6 Week Old**

*State v. Sharon Hancock, 2015 CR 3425*

**DAYTON, OH (12/2/2016)** – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that **SHARON HANCOCK**, 21, of Dayton, has been indicted for causing the death of his girlfriend's six-week-old daughter, Alisa Albarracin.

During the night of Friday, October 30, 2015, the mother of the infant called 911 and reported the child was having difficulty breathing. The infant was taken to Dayton Children's Hospital where doctors found the child to be suffering from cardiac arrest and respiratory arrest. The child died on November 8, 2015 from injuries sustained by the actions of the defendant.

Today, the defendant has been indicted on:

- One count of Involuntary Manslaughter
- Two counts of Endangering Children

A warrant has been issued for the arrest of the defendant. He is scheduled to be arraigned on December 15, 2016 at 8:30 a.m.
