Defendant Sentenced for Shooting 12-Year-Old Huber Heights Girl

State v. Bradley Harmon, 2013-CR-2844

DAYTON, OH (10/2/2015) – Prosecutor Mat Heck, Jr. announced that the defendant, 23 year-old **Bradley Allen Tyler Harmon**, was sentenced today for his conviction on seven felony counts relating to the shooting of a 12-year-old girl in her Huber Heights home on September 7, 2013.

During the early morning hours of September 7, 2013, the defendant entered the victim's Larcomb Drive residence and shot the 12-year-old in her face at pointblank range, using a stolen handgun, in a seemingly random act of violence.

The defendant was indicted on September 17, 2013 on:

- Two counts Aggravated Burglary
- Two counts Felonious Assault
- One count Robbery
- One count Tampering With Evidence
- One count Grand Theft of a Firearm

Because the defendant used a firearm in the commission of his acts, the aggravated burglary and felonious assault counts also included mandatory three-year firearm specifications.

On August 6, 2015, he was found guilty as charged on all counts and specifications after a jury trial. Today he was sentenced to a total of 25 years and 9 months in the penitentiary. The defendant was unremorseful and unapologetic. During the defendant's interview for the pre-sentence investigation report, the defendant stated that he felt justified in shooting the girl because she deserved to be shot.

Prosecutor Heck continued, "Thankfully, the victim survived the shooting, but suffered permanent injuries. This defendant clearly has no concern for the lives of others and deserves to serve every day of his sentence."
