## **Motion to Transfer Juvenile to Adult Court**

*State v. Dasean Harrison, JC2022-01594*

**DAYTON, OH (4/28/2022)** – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced the filing of an amended complaint and a motion to transfer **DASEAN HARRISON**, 17, of Dayton, to be tried as an adult for shooting a firearm inside Woodman Lanes in Kettering, striking two victims.

Shortly after midnight on Saturday, April 16, 2022, the defendant was with a group of people bowling at Woodman Lanes in Kettering. An altercation between the defendant and another person occurred, resulting in a fistfight. During the fight, the defendant pulled out a firearm and fired it, striking two victims. The victims were transported to the hospital.

Further investigation, including witness statements and video surveillance from inside the business, identified the defendant as the shooter.

The defendant was arrested and charged with felonious assault, carrying concealed weapons, and possession of a firearm in a liquor establishment.

Today, we have filed a motion to transfer and an amended complaint, charging the defendant with:

- Two counts Felonious Assault – deadly weapon
- Two counts Felonious Assault – serious physical harm
- One count Carrying Concealed Weapons
- One count Possession of a Firearm in a Liquor Establishment

All of the felonious assault counts also include 3-year firearm specifications.

Prosecutor Heck continued, “Once again, a 17-year-old has a gun and fires it in complete disregard for the safety of others. This defendant should not even have a firearm, and certainly should not have discharged it in a crowded bowling alley. Juveniles cannot be permitted to use firearms to solve their petty disputes, and when they do, they will be held accountable.”
