Three Indicted in Impersonating Police Officer Robberies

State v. Jason Harrold, Jacob Reigelsperger and Nikole Reigelsperger, 2015-CR-712

DAYTON, OH (03/27/2015) – Prosecutor Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that three defendants, 34 year-old **Jason Harrold**, 28 year-old **Jacob Reigelsperger** and 29 year-old **Nikole Reigelsperger**, have been indicted for crimes involving impersonating a police officer.

On March 7, 2015, defendant Harrold, dressed as a police officer, identified himself as a Dayton Police Officer to victims staying at the Ramada Inn at 2301 Wagner Ford Road in Harrison Township. The defendant took the victims' wallets, claiming he was looking for people with warrants, and never returned them. The defendant formerly was employed as a private security officer at the hotel.

On March 9, 2015, all three defendants robbed a person at the Reigelsperger home on Burgess Avenue in Harrison Township. Again, defendant Harrold was dressed as a police officer and identified himself as a Dayton Police Officer. Defendant Harrold handcuffed the victim and took items from the victim, saying that they could be retrieved from the Dayton Police.

Today, defendant Harrold was indicted on:

- Two counts Impersonating a Police Officer
- One count Aggravated Burglary
- One count Aggravated Robbery
- One count Abduction

Defendants Nikole and Jacob Reigelsperger were indicted on:

- One count Aggravated Robbery
- One count Possession of Heroin
- One count Possession of Cocaine
- One count Aggravated Possession of Drugs

All of the counts, except for the drug charges, include firearm specifications.

All three defendants are currently in custody in the Montgomery County Jail and will be arraigned on March 31, 2015 at 8:30 am.
