Ex-Boyfriend Indicted for Shooting at Car, Killing a Passenger

State v. Jamar Hayes, 2022-CR-1473

DAYTON, OH (10/24/2022) – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that **JAMAR ALLEN HAYES**, 26, of Dayton, has been indicted on charges related to a shooting that occurred on May 8, 2022 on U.S. 35, in which one of three occupants in a vehicle was fatally shot.

On the afternoon of Sunday, May 8, 2022, two people brought the victim of a shooting, later identified as 32-year-old Shauna Cameron, to Miami Valley Hospital. The victim was pronounced deceased. The investigation by Riverside Police determined the three victims had been in a vehicle on U.S. 35 near Woodman Drive when their vehicle was shot at by an occupant in another vehicle.

Further investigation determined the defendant was the shooter and was the ex-boyfriend of one of the victims.

Today, the Montgomery County Grand Jury indicted the defendant on:

- 2 counts of Murder
- 4 counts of Felonious Assault
- 1 counts of Discharge of a Firearm On or Near Prohibited Premises

All of the counts include 3-year firearm specifications. The counts of murder and felonious assault also have 5-year firearm specifications.

The defendant is currently in custody in the Montgomery County Jail, being held on a \$2,500,000 bond. He is scheduled to be arraigned on Thursday, October 27, 2022, at 8:30 am.
