Dayton Man Indicted for Carjacking Shooting

State v. Timothy Haywood 2015-CR-2139

DAYTON, OH (10/01/2015) – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that **Timothy Haywood, 28**, of Dayton, has been indicted for the May 3, 2015 shooting of a victim while taking the victim's car.

On Sunday, May 3, 2015, witnesses reported seeing the victim stumbling away from a vehicle after being shot. The defendant drove off in the victim's car, which was later found in Fairborn.

The victim suffered serious injuries and was hospitalized for a lengthy period before being moved to a long-term care facility.

Today, the defendant was indicted on:

- Two counts of Aggravated Robbery
- Two counts of Felonious Assault
- One count of Having Weapons While Under Disability

All of the counts have 3-year firearm specifications because the defendant used a gun.

The defendant is currently incarcerated at the Warren Correctional Institutional for a parole violation and is scheduled to be released on January 9, 2016. He will instead be taken into custody on these new counts.

In 2007, the defendant broke into a home in Huber Heights and stole an assault rifle and threatened the homeowner with a knife. He was convicted of aggravated robbery, grand theft of a firearm, burglary and having weapons while under disability (due to a prior drug conviction) and was sentenced to serve three years in prison.

Prosecutor Heck continued, "This defendant is clearly a dangerous and violent felon, who has no concern for the lives or property of others. Thankfully, the victim in this carjacking survived his injuries."
