Dayton Man Sentenced for August Homicide

State v. David Henderson, 2014-CR-2931

DAYTON, OH (05/14/2015) – Prosecutor Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that 31-year-old **David Patrick Henderson**, of Dayton, was sentenced to life in prison for killing DeAngelo Dewberry on August 23, 2014.

On August 23, 2014 at approximately 7:30 a.m., police were called on report of a shooting on Stratsburg Drive in Dayton. The victim, 25-year-old DeAngelo Dewberry, was shot multiple times and was transported to the hospital, where he later died from his injuries. Eyewitnesses described the shooter and the vehicle in which he fled the scene.

On Thursday, August 28, 2014 the defendant was apprehended by the U.S. Marshals. On September 5, 2014, the defendant was indicted by the Montgomery County Grand Jury on charges of murder, felonious assault and discharge of a firearm on or near prohibited premises.

On Friday, May 8, 2015 the defendant was found guilty of:

- One count Murder
- One count Felonious Assault with a deadly weapon
- One count Discharge of a Firearm on or Near Prohibited Premises

The defendant was sentenced to 15 years-to-life in prison. He will become eligible for consideration of parole after he has served at least 15 years of his sentence.
