Dayton Man Indicted in Second Cold Case Homicide

State v. Markus Henry, 2015-CR-3930

DAYTON, OH (05/10/2016) – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that 31-year-old **Markus Quantez Henry**, of Dayton, has been indicted for the shooting death of Sheila M. Tucker, of Dayton, on December 7, 2011.

On Wednesday, December 7, 2011, the Dayton Fire Department was dispatched to a garage fire on North McGee Street. Inside, the firefighters discovered the badly burned body of the victim. An autopsy determined the victim had been raped and shot to death, before being burned in the fire.

Subsequent investigation, including biological and DNA evidence, identified the defendant as the perpetrator.

Today, the defendant was indicted on:

- Three counts of Aggravated Murder
- Six counts of Murder
- Two counts of Aggravated Arson
- Two counts of Felonious Assault
- One count of Rape
- One count of Having Weapons While Under Disability

In an unrelated case, the defendant was indicted on June 29, 2015 for the stabbing death of Resa Anne Lee that occurred on April 16, 2010. That case is set to go to trial on August 8, 2016.

The defendant was arrested on June 26, 2015 and is currently in custody at the Montgomery County Jail, being held on a \$1,000,000 bond. He is scheduled to be arraigned on May 12, 2016 at 8:30 a.m.
