Dayton Man Sentenced in Connection to Fatal Shooting

State v. Marvin Herron, 2019-CR-2867

DAYTON, OH (11/20/2019) – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that **MARVIN MARCELLIS HERRON**, 24, of Dayton, was sentenced to a total of 15 years in prison for the shooting death of Matthew Aalim on Needmore Road on August 14, 2019.

On the night of Wednesday, August 14, 2019, Dayton Police were dispatched to the scene of a single vehicle car crash in the vicinity of 1651 Needmore Road, in Dayton. Upon arrival, they located a severely injured man, victim Matthew Aalim, inside the vehicle. The victim was removed from the vehicle and was taken to Miami Valley Hospital, where it was learned he had been shot in the back of his head. The victim succumbed to his injuries.

Further investigation determined that the defendant, in a second vehicle, had fired the fatal shot. A co-defendant, Jamichael Clark, was the driver of that vehicle.

On January 16, 2020, defendant Clark pled guilty to Obstructing Justice and Failure to Report a Crime.

On October 19, 2020, defendant Herron was found guilty of Involuntary Manslaughter and Discharge of a Firearm On or Near Prohibited Premises. The counts included 3-year and 5-year firearm specifications.

Today, defendant Herron was sentenced to a total of 15 years in prison. Defendant Clark will be sentenced at a later date.
