Former Trotwood Employee Sentenced for Voyeurism

State v. Dalton Hines 2015-CR-0423

DAYTON, OH (10/28/2015) – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that 52-year-old **Dalton Hines**, of Dayton, was sentenced to nine months in prison for his conviction on a count of voyeurism.

On February 5, 2015, the defendant was arrested by Sheriff's Deputies after they were contacted by employees of Hot Spot Tanning on McEwen Road in Washington Township, Ohio. A 16-year-old customer reported to the staff of the tanning salon that she had spotted the defendant holding a cell phone over the tanning booth wall, attempting to record the teen.

On March 20, 2015, just days after he resigned from his position as the Operations Manager for Trotwood's Public Works Department, the Defendant was indicted on one count of Voyeurism, a fifth-degree felony. He was found guilty as charged on September 25, 2015.

In addition to nine months incarceration, Judge Barbara Gorman also designated the defendant a Tier I Sex Offender, which requires he register his address with the Sheriff's Office annually for the next 15 years.

Prosecutor Heck continued, "I want to commend the 16 year old victim in this case for her courage in reporting the defendant's actions. Her willingness to come forward and testify against the defendant may prevent other young women from being victimized."
