## **Dayton Man Indicted for Shooting Death of Fiancée**

*State v. Kendall Hock, 2021-CR-0138*

**DAYTON, OH (04/20/2021)** – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that **KENDALL LEE HOCK**, 24, of Dayton, has been indicted for the shooting death of his fiancée, Anjelica Ramey, on January 11, 2021.

On Monday, January 11, 2021, the defendant called 911 and reported that the victim had shot herself with his firearm. It was learned the defendant had obtained the gun the day before, despite having previously been convicted of felony drug offenses. The defendant is legally barred from being in possession of a firearm. On January 20, 2021, the defendant was indicted on two counts of Having Weapons While Under Disability. The defendant was also indicted for two counts of Violating a Protection Order, from a matter unrelated to the shooting.

The investigation and autopsy determined that the defendant had shot the victim. Additionally, the autopsy revealed that the victim was in the very early stages of pregnancy at the time she was murdered.

Today, the Montgomery County Grand Jury indicted the defendant on additional counts:

- Two counts Murder
- One count Felonious Assault (deadly weapon)
- One count Felonious Assault (serious physical harm)
- One count Involuntary Manslaughter (unlawful termination of pregnancy)
- Two counts of Having Weapons While Under Disability
- Two counts of Violating a Protection Order

The counts of murder, felonious assault, and involuntary manslaughter include 3-year firearm specifications.

The defendant is currently in custody in the Montgomery County Jail, being held on a \$50,000 cash bond. The defendant will be arraigned on Thursday, April 22, 2021, at 8:30 a.m.
