Dayton Man Sentenced for Shooting Death of Fiancée

State v. Kendall Hock, 2021-CR-0138

DAYTON, OH (05/25/2022) – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that **KENDALL LEE HOCK**, 25, of Dayton, was sentenced to at least 14 years in prison for the shooting death of his fiancée, Anjelica Ramey, on January 11, 2021.

On Monday, January 11, 2021, the defendant called 911 and reported that the victim had shot herself with his firearm. It was learned the defendant had obtained the gun the day before, despite having previously been convicted of felony drug offenses. The defendant is legally barred from being in possession of a firearm.

The investigation and autopsy determined that the defendant had shot the victim. Additionally, the autopsy revealed that the victim was in the very early stages of pregnancy at the time she was murdered.

On April 29, 2022, the defendant entered a plea and was found guilty by the court on one count of Involuntary Manslaughter with a 3-year firearm specification and one count of Heaving Weapons While Under Disability.

Today, the defendant was sentenced to 11 years in the penitentiary for involuntary manslaughter, plus 3 additional years for using a firearm, which must be served consecutively. In addition, the defendant was ordered to pay \$2096.12 in restitution for the funeral expenses of the victim.
