## **Third Man Indicted in Fatal Shooting**

*State v. Jamar Howard, 2015-CR-2107/2*

**DAYTON, OH (08/31/2015)** – Prosecutor Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that a third man, 18-year-old **Jamar C. Howard**, from Trotwood, has been indicted in connection to the shooting death of Damarcus Bures that occurred on July 7, 2015.

On July 7, 2015, the victim and his girlfriend were in a car on North Delmar Avenue at Washington Park. The defendant and a co-defendant, Carlos Craig, entered the vehicle. Shortly thereafter, co-defendant Craig fatally shot the victim with a firearm provided by a third co-defendant, Robert Gilmore, Jr.

Today, defendant Howard has been indicted on:

- Two counts of Complicity to Commit Murder
- Two counts of Complicity to Commit Aggravated Robbery

Previously, on July 27, 2015, co-defendant Craig was indicted on:

- Four counts Murder
- Two counts of Felonious Assault
- Two counts of Aggravated Robbery
- One count Illegal Discharge of a Firearm on Prohibited Premises

Also on July 27, 2015, co-defendant Gilmore was indicted on:

- Two counts of Complicity to Commit Murder
- Two counts of Complicity to Commit Aggravated Robbery
- One count of Tampering With Evidence

The defendant is scheduled to be arraigned on September 3, 2015 at 8:30 a.m.
