Suspect in Triple Homicide Indicted on Gun Charges
State v. Octavius Humphrey, 2020-CR-3714

DAYTON, OH (12/04/2020) – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that **OCTAVIUS LAMONT HUMPHREY**, 41, of Dayton, has been indicted on six felony counts for illegally possessing firearms that were located during the investigation of a triple homicide on November 24, 2020.

During the early morning hours of Tuesday, November 24, 2020, Dayton police were dispatched on a report of three people who had been shot inside a home on North Gettysburg Avenue. Upon arrival, entry was made into the home where the deceased bodies of Dontay Alston, Michael Jackson, and Justin Wilson were discovered. All three victims had been fatally shot.

Further investigation identified the defendant as the primary suspect in the homicides. A search warrant was served on his Morgan Avenue home, where three firearms were located. The defendant has previously been convicted on drug crimes, as well as a crime of violence. Therefore, he is barred from possessing any firearms.

Today, the Montgomery County Grand Jury indicted the defendant for:

- Three counts of Having Weapons While Under Disability – prior offense of violence
- Three counts of Having Weapons While Under Disability – prior drug conviction

The investigation into the homicides is ongoing.

The defendant is currently being held in the Montgomery County Jail on a \$1,000,000 bond. He is scheduled to be arraigned on Tuesday, December 8, 2020, at 8:30 a.m.
