Man Indicted for Ethnic Intimidation of Deputies

State v. Aaron J. Johnson, 2015-CR-0020

DAYTON, OH (01/30/2015) – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that 28 year old **Aaron J. Johnson**, has been indicted on four counts of Ethnic Intimidation for an incident that occurred on January 1, 2015.

In the early morning hours of New Year's Day, a call was made to 911 in which the defendant stated that he would shoot any officers that came near him. In further conversations between the defendant and a 911 dispatcher, the defendant further stated his intentions that he would kill any Caucasian police officers that responded to his location. Several Sheriff's Office Deputies responded to the Castlewood Avenue location from which the 911 calls were made, which is located in Harrison Township.

The defendant made numerous threats about "killing cops", especially "white cops", and continued to make a number of racially charged insults.

Today, the defendant was indicted on four counts of Ethnic Intimidation, a felony of the fifth degree. The defendant is currently in custody in the Montgomery County Jail, being held on a \$25,000 bond. He is scheduled to be arraigned on February 3, 2015 at 8:30 a.m.
