## **Michigan Man Sentenced for Huber Heights Shooting**

*State v. Keith Johnson, 2015-CR-2353*

**DAYTON, OH (11/24/2015)** – Prosecutor Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that 46-year-old **Keith L. Johnson**, of Ferndale, Michigan, was sentenced to 22 years in prison for breaking into a home in Huber Heights and shooting at one of the residents on August 2, 2015.

On August 2, 2015, the defendant broke into a home on Blackshear Drive in Huber Heights. The home was where the mother of his children lived. Armed with a gun, he held the woman at gunpoint. When the victim's brother tried to intercede, the defendant shot him twice. A struggle ensued over the gun, and Johnson was also shot, before he fled from the residence.

On August 21, 2015 the defendant was indicted for aggravated burglary, felonious assault and kidnapping charges. After a jury trial, the defendant was found guilty as charged on November 10, 2015.

The defendant was sentenced to a mandatory total of 22 years in prison, including six years because the defendant used a firearm in committing his offenses.

Prosecutor Heck continued, "This defendant came to Huber Heights from his home in Michigan and shot a man who was trying to protect his sister. He certainly deserves to serve a lengthy prison sentence."
