Huber Heights Man Indicted for Englewood Stabbing Death

State v. Lytus Jordan, III, 2023-CR-0766

DAYTON, OH (03/22/2023) – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that **LYTUS JORDAN, III**, 37, of Huber Heights, has been indicted on counts in connection to the fatal stabbing of another man at Hematite, Inc. in Englewood on March 12, 2023.

On Sunday, March 12, 2023, Englewood Police were dispatched to Hematite on Lau Parkway after employees found the bloody body of a co-worker in a restroom. The victim was identified as 42-year-old Shaunn Monroe of Dayton. The victim had been stabbed to death.

The investigation, including video surveillance and other evidence, determined that the defendant had been in a verbal altercation with the victim earlier. The two went into the restroom and a short time later only the defendant left the restroom. Once the defendant was identified, he was taken into custody at the business.

Today, the Montgomery County Grand Jury indicted the defendant for:

- Two counts of Murder
- Two counts of Felonious Assault
- Three counts of Tampering with Evidence

The defendant is currently being held in the Montgomery County Jail on a \$1,000,000 bond. He will be arraigned on Tuesday, March 28, 2023, at 8:30 a.m.
