**Huber Heights Man Indicted for Fatal Traffic Crash**

*State v. Michael King, 2021-CR-4164*

**DAYTON, OH (01/20/2022)** – Montgomery County Prosecutor Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that **MICHAEL ANDREW KING**, 56, of Huber Heights, has been indicted for counts related to a fatal traffic crash that occurred on August 21, 2021, in Riverside.

On Saturday, August 21, 2021, Riverside police and medics were dispatched to a multiple-vehicle traffic crash in the 2200 block of Brandt Pike. Upon arrival, they located a Hyundai that had been struck head-on by a Chevrolet. Three people were taken from the Hyundai and were transported to the hospital with significant injuries. The rear seat passenger, identified as 64-year-old Pamela Jacobs, died from her injuries.

The investigation by the Riverside police department determined the defendant had been traveling approximately 70mph in a 40mph zone, crossed the double-yellow centerline in a no-passing zone, and struck the victims' vehicle head-on. At the time of the crash, the defendant had both alcohol and marihuana in his system, above the legal limit.

Today, the Montgomery County Grand Jury indicted the defendant on:

- Four counts of Aggravated Vehicular Homicide
- One count of Operating a Vehicle While Under the Influence - Marihuana
- One count of Operating a Vehicle While Under the Influence of Drugs, Alcohol, or a combination of both
- One count of OVI

A warrant has been issued for the arrest of the defendant. He will be arraigned on Thursday, February 3, 2022, at 8:30 a.m.
