Dayton Man Sentenced for Sex Crimes; Wife Previously Sentenced

State v. Michael Lewis, 2019-CR-2644/1

DAYTON, OH (11/10/2020) – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that **MICHAEL A. LEWIS**, 39, of Dayton, was sentenced to 8 years in prison after his conviction on counts related to the sexual abuse of two juvenile males. The defendant's wife, **AMY LEWIS**, 43, was previously sentenced to 8 years in prison after her conviction on similar charges.

The victim, now an adult, disclosed to his mother in 2018 that both defendants had been sexually abusing him since he was approximately 14 years old. The victim's mother reported the disclosure to Dayton Police. The investigation revealed that a friend of the victim had also been sexually abused by the defendants.

On August 16, 2019, defendant Michael Lewis was indicted for:

- Seven counts of Unlawful Sexual Conduct with a Minor
- Six counts of Sexual Imposition
- One count of Soliciting
- One count of Public Indecency

Defendant Amy Lewis was indicted for:

- Nine counts of Unlawful Sexual Conduct with a Minor

On June 25, 2020, defendant Amy Lewis was found guilty as charged, and on August 20, 2020, she was sentenced to a total of 8 years in prison, and was designated a Tier II Sex Offender. Tier II Sex Offender designation requires the defendant register in person with the sheriff's office every 180 days for 25 years upon release from prison.

On October 5, 2020, defendant Michael Lewis was indicted for an additional count of Unlawful Sexual Conduct with a Minor, and one count of Disseminating Matter Harmful to Juveniles.

On October 20, 2020, the defendant was found guilty as charged on all counts.

Today, the defendant was sentenced to a total of 8 years in prison, and was also designated a Tier II Sex Offender.
