Dayton Man Indicted in Fatal Shooting In Trotwood

Shooting victim dropped off at Dayton's V.A. Center

State v. Dshawn Lynch, 2016-CR-1195

DAYTON, OH (05/02/2016) – Prosecutor Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that 20-year-old **Dshawn Z. Lynch**, of Dayton, has been indicted for the April 15, 2016 shooting death of Thomas Lee Johnson.

On Friday, April 15, 2016, the victim, 48-year-old Thomas Lee Johnson was shot at a Speedway gas station on Olive Road in Trotwood. Another person, who was with the victim at the time of the shooting, drove the victim to the Dayton V.A. Medical Center on West Third Street. The victim died as a result of his injuries.

Eyewitness and other evidence identified the defendant as the shooter.

Today, the defendant was indicted on:

- Two counts Murder
- Two counts Felonious Assault
- One count Trafficking in Counterfeit Controlled Substances
- One count Intimidation of a Crime Witness
- One count of Having Weapons While Under Disability

The murder and felonious assault counts include a mandatory 3 year firearm specification because the defendant used a gun during the commission of those crimes.

The defendant is currently in custody, being held on a \$1,000,000 bond. He is scheduled to be arraigned on May 3, 2016 at 8:30 am.
