Dayton Man Indicted for Aggravated Murder in Double Homicide

State v. Davion Lyons, 2016-CR-3742

DAYTON, OH (12/9/2016) – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that 25-year-old **DAVION L. LYONS**, of Dayton, has been indicted on charges relating to the double homicide that occurred on Victor Avenue, in Dayton on November 29, 2016.

On November 29, 2016, the defendant went to the home of 40-year-old John L. Dixon, on Victor Avenue. While inside the residence, he shot Dixon and two other victims, 56-year-old Donald J. Nesbit, and a 25-year-old female. Victim Dixon died inside the residence. Victim Nesbit was transported to the hospital, where he died two days later. The third shooting victim was seriously injured but survived.

Today, the defendant was indicted on:

- Six counts of Aggravated Murder
- Six counts of Felonious Assault
- Four counts of Aggravated Burglary
- Four counts of Aggravated Robbery
- One count of Having Weapons While Under Disability – prior drug conviction
- One count of Having Weapons While Under Disability – prior offense of violence

All of the counts, except for the Having Weapons While Under Disability counts, have 3-year Firearm Specifications because the defendant used a firearm during the commission of his crimes.

The defendant is currently in custody, being held on a \$1,000,000 bond. He is scheduled to be arraigned on December 13, 2016, at 8:30 am.
