**Kelly D. Madzey Promoted to  
Chief Assistant Prosecuting Attorney, Juvenile Division**



**DAYTON, OH (06/23/2022)** – Montgomery County Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced that Ms. Kelly D. Madzey has been promoted to the position of Chief Assistant Prosecuting Attorney of the Juvenile Division of the Prosecutor's Office.

In 2002, Ms. Madzey graduated from the University of North Dakota, in Grand Forks, North Dakota, majoring in Criminal Justice. In 2005, she received her law degree from the University of North Dakota School of Law. From October 2005 until she joined the prosecutor's office, Kelly was a staff attorney for the 12<sup>th</sup> District Court of Appeals in Middletown, Ohio.

In May 2008, Kelly joined the office and was assigned to the Appellate Division. She has also been assigned to the Juvenile Division, Intake/Grand Jury Section, and Criminal Division. She served as the Supervising Attorney of the Child Abuse Bureau from January 2014 until September 2015, when she was again assigned as a Criminal Docket Attorney. From August 2016 to August 2017, Kelly was the Supervising Attorney of the Intake/Grand Jury Section. In August 2017, she was promoted to Criminal Trial Supervisor.

As Chief of the Juvenile Division, Kelly will supervise the Assistant Prosecutors and support staff working in the Juvenile Delinquency section and the Child Protection Unit of the office, which represents Montgomery County Children Services in abuse, neglect, and dependency cases.
