Kettering Woman Indicted for Additional Counts
Previously Indicted for Unlawful Sexual Conduct with a Minor
State v. Justina F. McBride, 2023-CR-0035

DAYTON, OH (01/10/2023) – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that **JUSTINA FAITH MCBRIDE**, 46, of Kettering, has been indicted on additional charges for continued contact with the victim after having been previously indicted for having a sexual relationship with a 14-year-old boy.

On September 7, 2022, Kettering police officers received a complaint that an adult female had an inappropriate sexual relationship with a minor child. The child’s mother reported the matter to the police after receiving the information from a friend.

Further investigation determined the defendant had sexual conduct with the minor on several occasions over the past year.

On October 7, 2022, the Montgomery County Grand Jury indicted the defendant on:

- Four counts of Unlawful Sexual Conduct with a Minor
- Two counts of Sexual Imposition

On October 28, 2022, the defendant was released from jail after posting a \$50,000 bond. She was ordered to have no contact with any minors or the victim in the case. On December 28, 2022, it was learned that the defendant had violated the terms of her bond as she had continued abuse and had contact with the victim, including meeting him in person, providing the victim with gifts, as well as texting inappropriate photos of each other.

Today, the defendant was indicted on additional counts:

- One count of Violation of Protection Order while committing a felony offense
- One count of Pandering Sexually Oriented Matter Involving a Minor
- Two counts of Illegal Use of Minor in Nudity Oriented Material
- Two counts of Disseminating Matter Harmful to Juveniles

Prosecutor Heck added, “The fact that the defendant was out on bond, having been released by the judge, and yet continued to have contact and abuse the victim after being indicted is very disturbing. This defendant needs to remain in jail in order to protect the victim from further abuse.”

The defendant is currently in custody, being held on a \$100,000 bond. She will be arraigned on the additional charges on Thursday, January 12, 2023, at 8:30 am.
