**Dayton Man Indicted for January Murder**  
*State v. Shaquonne McCurty, 2021-CR-0314*

**DAYTON, OH (02/05/2021)** – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that **SHAQUONNE CARLELL MCCURTY**, 24, of Dayton, has been indicted for causing the shooting death of Ja’Darion Glass on January 17, 2021.

On the evening of Sunday, January 17, 2021, Dayton police officers were dispatched on a report of a person having been shot in the 4500 block of Germantown Street. Upon arrival, they located the deceased body of a victim, identified as 17-year-old Ja’Darion Glass.

Further investigation identified the defendant was the shooter. The defendant and the victim had been involved in an on-going dispute for the past couple of months.

Today, the Montgomery County Grand Jury has indicted the defendant for:

- Two counts of Murder
- Two counts of Felonious Assault with a deadly weapon
- One count of Felonious Assault causing serious physical harm
- Two counts of Having Weapons While Under Disability

The counts of murder and felonious assault include 3-year firearm specifications.

The defendant is currently in custody in the Montgomery County Jail, being held on a \$1,000,000 bond. He will be arraigned on Tuesday, February 9, 2021, at 8:30 a.m.
