23-Year-Old Man Indicted for Harrison Township Rape and Robbery *State v. Katrell McMurtry, 2020-CR-3917*

DAYTON, OH (12/29/2020) – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced that **KATRELL WILLIAM MCMURTRY**, 23, has been indicted on counts in connection to the robbery and rape of a 27 year old woman.

On Friday, November 13, 2020, the victim went to an apartment on Northcutt Place in Harrison Township. The defendant invited her inside the apartment, then forcibly raped her at knifepoint and took her jacket and cellphone. The victim fled from the apartment and called 911.

Further investigation, including DNA and other evidence, identified the defendant as the perpetrator.

The Montgomery County Grand Jury has indicted the defendant for:

- Four counts of Rape
- One count of Kidnapping for sexual activity
- One count of Aggravated Robbery
- Two counts of Kidnapping

It is believed this defendant may have sexually assaulted additional victims. If you or someone you know have been a victim or have information that may assist in the investigation and prosecution, please call Detective Patrick O'Connell at 937-890-3430.

A warrant has been issued for the arrest of the defendant. He is scheduled to be arraigned on Tuesday, January 5, 2021, at 8:30 a.m.
