Dayton Man Indicted for Shooting Death of Accomplice

State v. Curtis McShann, 2016 CR 3361/1

DAYTON, OH (11/4/2016) – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that **Curtis M. McShann**, 29, of Dayton, has been indicted on multiple charges in connection with a shooting that occurred on October 25, 2016 on Riverside Drive in Dayton.

About 11:45 p.m. on Tuesday, October 25, 2016, Dayton Police responded to 3325 Riverside Drive, Dayton, on reports of multiple shots fired. Upon arrival, the officers located 27-year-old Brandon Lanier, who had been shot and ultimately died from his injuries. Three other shooting victims had been removed from the location and taken to the hospital by private citizens. Based upon statements made by witnesses, two co-defendants, McShann and 22-year-old Jamarko E. Walker, Jr. were arrested.

The co-defendants, along with the deceased, went to the Riverside Drive address and attempted to commit a robbery of the residents inside the home. During the incident, multiple shots were fired, from both inside and outside the residence.

Today, co-defendant McShann has been indicted on:

- Four counts of Murder
- Five counts of Aggravated Robbery with a deadly weapon
- Four counts of Felonious Assault with a deadly weapon
- Four counts of Felonious Assault causing serious harm
- One count of Aggravated Burglary with a deadly weapon
- One count of Discharge of a Firearm On or Near Prohibited Premises
- One count of Improper Discharge of a Firearm At or Into a Habitation
- Three counts of Having Weapons While Under Disability for prior offense of violence
- One count of Having Weapons While Under Disability for prior drug conviction

All of the counts include 3-year Firearm Specifications and all counts except for the having weapons under disability and discharge of a firearm on or near prohibited premises include Repeat Violent Offender Specifications.

The defendant is in custody at the Montgomery County Jail being held on a \$1,000,000 bond. He will be arraigned on November 8, 2016 at 8:30 a.m.

Co-defendant Walker will remain in custody pending further investigation.
