Ms. Kimberly A. Melnick
Promoted to Violent Crimes Bureau



DAYTON, OH (2/3/2021) – Montgomery County Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced that Ms. Kimberly A. Melnick has been promoted to the Violent Crimes Bureau of the Criminal Division of the Prosecutor's Office. The Violent Crimes Bureau handles the prosecution of homicide and other high-profile cases in Montgomery County.

Ms. Melnick graduated from Wright State University in 1990, majoring in Marketing. In 1993, she received her law degree from the University of Dayton School of Law. In January 1994, Kim joined the prosecutor's office and was assigned to the Child Support Enforcement Division. She was subsequently assigned to the Juvenile Division and then the Intake/Grand Jury Section. In July 1997, Kim was assigned to the Criminal Division as a Criminal Docket Attorney.

Kim left the Prosecutor's Office in 1998 for two years to work in private practice, returning in May 2000. Then, in April 2002, Kim left the office and relocated to Golden, Colorado where she served as a Deputy District Attorney for Jefferson County, Colorado. She returned to our office in October 2006 as a Criminal Docket Attorney and became the Supervising Attorney of the Adult Protection Unit. In May 2019, Kim was promoted to Criminal Trial Team Supervisor.

Prosecutor Heck said, "Kim has extensive experience as a criminal docket prosecutor, handling a variety of felony criminal cases. I believe her experience, knowledge of the law, and ability to communicate with victims, police officers, and judges in a professional and effective manner makes her an excellent asset to the Violent Crimes Bureau."
