**Brookville Man Sentenced for Fatal Traffic Crash**

*State v. Nathan Milby, 2022-CR-2182*

**DAYTON, OH (12/14/2022)** – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced that **NATHAN THOMAS MILBY**, 20, of Brookville was sentenced to serve 180 days in the Montgomery County Jail for causing a fatal traffic crash in Perry Township on March 15, 2022.

On Tuesday, March 15, 2022, Perry Township police were dispatched to a traffic crash on Diamond Mill Road near Snake Road. The evidence showed that the defendant was driving north on Diamond Mill Road at a high rate of speed when he attempted to pass two other vehicles, striking another vehicle head-on. The victim, 30-year-old Carl S. Broadstock was taken by medics to Miami Valley Hospital, but he was pronounced dead shortly after arrival.

The defendant was in a no-passing zone at the time of the crash at the crest of a hill. Neither vehicle had time to avoid the head-on crash.

On November 2, 2022, the defendant pled by a Bill of Information to one count of Vehicular Homicide, which is a first-degree misdemeanor.

The defendant was sentenced to the maximum possible sentence of 180 days in the Montgomery County Jail, plus the defendant's driver's license was suspended for five years.

Prosecutor Heck added, "This defendant killed a completely innocent man due to his careless disregard for the safety of others. Not only was he driving nearly 80 mph, but he was passing other vehicles in a no-passing zone, and struck the victim's car at the crest of a hill."
