**Woman Indicted for Summit Square Homicide**  
*State v. Kenyatta Miliner, 2020-CR-2774*

**DAYTON, OH (12/23/2020)** – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that **KENYATTA DAVONNA MILINER**, 26, of Dayton, has been indicted for the fatal shooting of Shareef Tillman on May 24, 2020 on Summit Square.

On the evening of Saturday, May 23, 2020, Dayton Police were dispatched to a shooting at the Summit Square Apartments. Upon arrival, they located the victim, Shareef Tillman, who had been shot. The victim was transported to the hospital, but died from his injuries.

Further investigation determined an argument had occurred between a couple of people at the apartment complex. The defendant took a firearm from a male and fired shots directly into the crowd gathered around the argument.

Today, the Montgomery County Grand Jury indicted the defendant for:

- Two counts of Murder
- Two counts of Felonious Assault

All of the counts include 3-year firearm specifications.

A warrant has been issued for the arrest of the defendant. She is scheduled to be arraigned on Tuesday, January 5, 2021, at 8:30 a.m.
