## **Jury Finds Dayton Man Guilty for Murder Over \$10**

*State v. James Miller, 2020-CR-2034*

**DAYTON, OH (04/01/2021)** – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that **JAMES C. MILLER**, 57, of Dayton, has been found guilty as charged after a jury trial on counts in connection to the stabbing death of 58-year-old Terry Young after an argument over \$10.00.

On Wednesday, July 8, 2020, the defendant and the victim were “scrapping” and got into an argument in an alley behind Gebhart Street in Dayton. Witnesses reported that the men got into an argument over ten dollars that the defendant thought the victim had cheated him out of. The defendant stabbed the victim twice in the neck with a knife, then got into his vehicle and drove towards the victim, striking him before fleeing. The victim, identified as Terry Young, of Dayton, was pronounced dead at the scene.

On October 26, 2020, the Montgomery County Grand Jury indicted the defendant for:

- Two counts of Murder
- Two counts of Felonious Assault with a deadly weapon
- One count of Felonious Assault causing serious harm

The defendant was arrested in the town of Haysi in southwest Virginia and was extradited to Montgomery County.

Today, after a trial, the jury returned verdicts of guilty as charged on all counts. The defendant will be sentenced on Thursday, April 15, 2021, at 2:30 p.m.
