Dayton Man Indicted for Murder Over \$10

State v. James Miller, 2020-CR-2034

DAYTON, OH (10/26/2020) – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that **JAMES C. MILLER**, 56, of Dayton, has been indicted on counts in connection to the murder of 58-year-old Terry Young after an argument over \$10.00.

On Wednesday, July 8, 2020, the defendant and the victim were “scrapping” and got into an argument in an alley behind Gebhart Street in Dayton. Witnesses reported that the men got into an argument over ten dollars that the defendant thought the victim had cheated him out of. The defendant stabbed the victim in the neck with a knife, and then got into his vehicle and drove over the victim before fleeing. The victim, identified as Terry Young, of Dayton, was pronounced dead at the scene.

Today, the Montgomery County Grand Jury indicted the defendant for:

- Two counts of Murder
- Two counts of Felonious Assault with a deadly weapon
- One count of Felonious Assault causing serious harm

The defendant was arrested in the town of Haysi in southwest Virginia and was extradited to Montgomery County, and is currently being held in the Montgomery County Jail. He is scheduled to be arraigned on Tuesday, October 27, 2020, at 8:30 a.m.
