**Parolee Indicted for Harrison Township Assault & Robbery**

*State v. Marcus Miller, 2016-CR-0258*

**DAYTON, OH (01/28/2016)** – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that **Marcus Miller**, 24, of Dayton, has been indicted for the robbery and shooting of a 71-year-old man in Harrison Township.

On January 20, 2016, the defendant got into the 71-year-old victim's car and, at gunpoint, ordered him to drive to an ATM and withdraw cash. The victim complied with the defendant's orders, withdrawing \$100 from a nearby ATM. When the defendant then ordered the victim to withdraw more money, the victim refused and the defendant fired the gun twice, striking the victim in his stomach and the vehicle's windshield.

The defendant fled, but the victim was able to get the license plate number of the car the defendant drove away.

Today, the defendant was indicted on:

- Three counts of Aggravated Robbery
- Two counts of Felonious Assault
- One count of Kidnapping
- One count of Having Weapons While Under Disability

Additionally, the defendant was indicted with Repeat Violent Offender Specifications and three year firearm specifications. The defendant was on parole at the time of the incident, having been released from prison on May 5, 2015 after serving nearly six years in prison for aggravated robbery and felonious assault convictions out of Hamilton County in 2009.

Prosecutor Heck added, "This defendant, out of prison just eight months, used a firearm he possessed illegally and shot an elderly victim. Clearly, his time in prison did not rehabilitate him. This defendant remains a dangerous and violent individual."

The defendant is currently in custody, being held on a \$500,000 bond. He is scheduled to be arraigned on February 2, 2016 at 8:30am.
