Dayton Man Sentenced for Murder

State v. Curtis Moody, 2014-CR-3237

DAYTON, OH (11/18/2015) – Prosecutor Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that 33-year-old **Curtis Anthony Moody**, of Dayton, was sentenced to 24 years to life in prison for his conviction of the July 17, 2014 shooting death of Jeffrey Farr, Sr.

On July 17, 2014, Dayton Police received reports of a shooting on Germantown Street. Officers discovered the body of the victim, who had been shot multiple times. Further investigation and interview of witnesses identified the defendant as the shooter. The victim and the defendant had been involved in an ongoing argument for approximately a year.

On November 13, 2015, after a jury trial, the defendant was found guilty as charged on counts of Murder and Felonious Assault. The defendant was also found guilty by the court after a bench trial of Having Weapons While Under Disability, having previously been convicted of a crime of violence.

The defendant has multiple prior convictions including abduction, domestic violence, felonious assault, tampering with evidence and possession of cocaine. He was on probation for domestic violence at the time of this shooting.

The 24 years-to-life sentence was the maximum consecutive sentence possible.
