## **Dayton Man Sentenced for Thanksgiving Day Murder**

*State v. D'Maughn Moore, 2019-CR-4138*

**DAYTON, OH (12/5/2022)** – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that **D'MAUGHN DAVION MOORE**, 27, was sentenced to serve at least 42 to 46 years to life in prison after being convicted for shooting at multiple people, killing one, on Thanksgiving day, 2019.

On November 28, 2019, 30-year-old David Anton Blane was with his infant child and another man in front of a house on Kenwood Avenue in Dayton. The defendant drove past the home, firing multiple shots from his vehicle, striking both men, and killing Blane. The other adult victim, a valid CCW permit holder, returned fire at the defendant but did not strike him. The defendant lost control of his vehicle and crashed before running away.

Further investigation identified the defendant as the shooter. He was taken into custody on December 16, 2019, when he was in court on an unrelated case.

On December 23, 2019, the Montgomery County Grand Jury indicted the defendant for:

- Two counts of Murder
- Five counts of Felonious Assault
- Three counts of Discharge of a Firearm On or Near Prohibited Premises

The Murder and Felonious Assault counts include 3-year and 5-year firearm specifications because the defendant fired his weapon from a moving motor vehicle. The counts of Discharge of a Firearm On or Near Prohibited Premises include a 3-year firearm specification.

On November 18, 2022, after a trial, the jury returned verdicts of guilty as charged on all counts and specifications.

Today, the defendant was sentenced to serve between 42 and 46 years to life in prison.
