## **16 Year Old Transferred to Adult Court in Dayton Mall Shooting**

*State v. Keyan Moore, JC-14-8216*

**DAYTON, OH (03/03/2015)** – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that 16 year old **Keyan Moore**, of Middletown, has been transferred to the adult criminal division to be tried as an adult. Moore is charged with Involuntary Manslaughter and Robbery for the fatal shooting of his accomplice outside the Dayton Mall on December 20, 2014.

On the morning of December 20, 2014, three teens from Middletown, Ohio were outside the Dayton Mall when one of the teens, 16-year-old Jawaad Jabbar, displayed a fully operable and loaded firearm. While attempting to commit an armed robbery of an adult, the robber, Jabbar was fatally shot by the adult, who was a valid CCW permit holder.

The Miami Township Police Department investigation showed that the defendant participated in the attempted robbery. Under Ohio law, an individual is culpable for any death that occurs during the commission of a robbery, including the death of an accomplice.

The defendant is facing a possible 16 year adult prison sentence if found guilty.

The case will now proceed to the Montgomery County Grand Jury.
