Dayton Man Sentenced for Murdering Wife

State v. Task Moreland, Jr., 2021-CR-3009

DAYTON, OH (2/8/2023) – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced that **TASK TRESONARD MORELAND, JR.**, 38, of Dayton, was sentenced to 18 years to life in prison after being convicted of the shooting death of his wife, Tiffany Moreland, on April 14, 2019.

On the afternoon of Tuesday, April 14, 2019, Dayton police responded to an apartment in the 400 block of Ryburn Avenue on the report of a shooting. Upon arrival, they located a victim, later identified as 38-year-old Tiffany Yvette Moreland, who had been shot in the chest, as well as a 9mm semi-automatic handgun. The officers rendered aid until medics arrived. The victim was pronounced deceased at the scene.

Further investigation determined the defendant had shot the victim inside the apartment during an argument.

On November 4, 2021, the Montgomery County Grand Jury indicted the defendant for:

- Two counts of Murder
- Two counts of Felonious Assault

All of the counts included 3-year firearm specifications.

On July 20, 2022, after a trial, the jury found the defendant guilty as charged on all counts and specifications.

Today, the defendant was sentenced to a total of 15 years to life in prison plus an additional, consecutive, 3 years for the firearm specification.
