64-Year-Old Dayton Man Indicted for Sex Offenses

State v. Larry Nalls, 2020-CR-1992

DAYTON, OH (7/30/2020) – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that **LARRY NALLS**, 64, of Dayton, has been indicted for multiple counts of sexual assault against a minor child and for producing over a dozen nude photographs of the same minor child. He was indicted for an additional count of having a weapon while under disability.

In November, 2018, the victim, a minor female, disclosed that the defendant had taken numerous nude photos of her and had additionally engaged in sexual conduct with her in July and August of that year.

Further investigation, including a search of the defendant's residence and electronics, uncovered evidence consistent with the child's accusations, as well as a firearm. The Defendant is barred from possessing a firearm because he was previously convicted of rape in 1989. The defendant served 17 years in prison in that case and was released in 2006.

Today, the Montgomery County Grand Jury indicted the defendant for:

- 18 counts of Illegal Use of a Minor in Nudity-Oriented Material or Performance
- One count of Unlawful Sexual Conduct with a Minor
- One count of Having Weapons While Under Disability
- One count of Gross Sexual Imposition by force
- One count of Sexual Imposition of a minor at least 13 but less than 16 years of age

A warrant has been issued for the arrest of the defendant. He will be arraigned on Thursday, August 13, 2020, at 8:30 a.m.
