66-Year-Old Dayton Man Receives 56 Year Prison Sentence for Sex Offenses *State v. Larry Nalls, 2020-CR-1992*

DAYTON, OH (9/22/2022) – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that **LARRY NALLS**, 66, of Dayton, was sentenced to a total of 56 ½ years in prison after being convicted on multiple counts of sexual assault against a minor child and for producing over a dozen nude photographs of the same minor child.

In November 2018, the victim, a minor female, disclosed that the defendant had taken numerous nude photos of her and had additionally engaged in sexual conduct with her in July and August of that year.

Further investigation, including a search of the defendant’s residence and electronics, uncovered evidence consistent with the child’s accusations, as well as a firearm. The Defendant is barred from possessing a firearm because he was previously convicted of rape in 1989. The defendant served 17 years in prison in that case and was released in 2006.

The Montgomery County Grand Jury indicted the defendant on multiple counts in July 2020.

On August 28, 2022, after a trial, the jury returned verdicts of guilty as charged on 27 counts of Illegal Use of a Minor in Nudity-Oriented Material or Performance, one count of Gross Sexual Imposition by force, one count of Sexual Imposition of a Minor over 13 but less than 16 years of age, and one count of Having Weapons While Under Disability.

Today, the defendant was sentenced to a total of 56 ½ years in prison.

Prosecutor Heck added, “This defendant has shown no remorse for the abuse and sexual assault of the child victim in this case. Today’s well-deserved sentence will ensure that this predator never again sexually assaults another victim.”
