Miamisburg Man Designated Sexually Violent Predator and Sentenced *State v. Scott Pate, 2019-CR-1019*

DAYTON, OH (01/31/2020) – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that **SCOTT E. PATE**, 55, of Miamisburg, was sentenced to 10 consecutive terms of life without the possibility of parole, plus an additional, consecutive, 58 years to life in prison.

On April 1, 2019, the defendant was indicted on 10 counts of Rape of a Child under 10 years of age, 10 counts of Gross Sexual Imposition of a child under 13 years of age, and two counts of Disseminating Matter Harmful to Juveniles. As part of the ongoing investigation, it was learned that the defendant sexually abused another child in 2004. On May 14, 2019, the defendant was indicted on four additional counts of Unlawful Sexual Conduct with a Minor. In addition to the new counts, Sexually Violent Predator (SVP) Specifications were added to the original counts in the indictment.

On October 7, 2019, after a trial, the jury found the defendant guilty as charged on 25 of the 26 counts in the indictment.

On December 20, 2019, a separate trial to the court was held on the SVP Specifications. The court found the defendant guilty as charged on the specifications.

Today, the defendant received 10 consecutive life without parole sentences, plus an additional and consecutive 58 years to life.

Prosecutor Heck added, “This defendant will spend the rest of his life in prison, where he will be unable to sexually assault any more children. Shockingly, this defendant has never showed any sign of remorse for his actions.”
