Girl Scout Mom Sentenced for Theft

State v. Kelley Phillips, 2015-CR-661

DAYTON, OH (11/17/2015) – Prosecutor Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that 38-year-old **Kelly Phillips** was sentenced to community control sanctions following her conviction for felony theft from the Girl Scouts of Western Ohio.

In March of 2014, the defendant failed to turn over \$1,089.00 after selling Girl Scout cookies on behalf of her daughter's troop.

On October 19, 2015, a jury found the defendant guilty as charged of one count of Theft in an amount exceeding \$1,000.00, a fifth degree felony.

Judge Singer noted at sentencing that the defendant received community control sanctions at the request of the Girls Scouts of Western Ohio, and over the objection of the Assistant Prosecuting Attorney who recommended that the defendant receive some period of incarceration.

As part of the defendant's community control sanctions, she was ordered to pay full restitution to the Girl Scouts of Western Ohio.
