## **Dayton Man Indicted for Beating and Burning Girlfriend With Iron** *State v. Malik Rasheed, 2022-CR-3026*

**DAYTON, OH (11/1/2022)** – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that **MALIK TALEEB RASHEED**, 46, of Dayton, has been indicted on counts for beating a woman with an iron and causing burns to her face on October 22, 2022.

On the evening of Saturday, October 22, 2022, Dayton police officers were dispatched to a residence on Kenilworth Avenue on a report of domestic violence. Upon arrival, they located a female victim who had been hit in the face with a hot iron, causing injuries.

Further investigation determined the defendant and the victim had an argument and the defendant had struck the victim in the face with a hot iron, causing cuts and burns. The defendant then started beating the victim with his fists and kicking her. The victim fled from the residence and went to a neighbor's residence and called 911.

Today, the Montgomery County Grand Jury indicted the defendant for:

- One count of Felonious Assault – serious physical harm
- One count of Felonious Assault – deadly weapon

The defendant is currently being held in the Montgomery County Jail on a \$100,000 bond. He is scheduled to be arraigned on Thursday, November 3, 2022, at 8:30 a.m.
