One of Two Former U.D. Athletes Found Guilty

State v. Jalen Robinson 2015-CR-0887/2

DAYTON, OH (06/12/2015) – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that former University of Dayton student **Jalen T. Robinson**, 21, was found guilty of three counts of Trespass in a Habitation.

During the early morning hours of Sunday, December 14, 2014, a number of University of Dayton dormitory rooms were broken into, from which items were stolen. In addition to video surveillance, the defendants were positively identified.

The next day, Monday, December 15, 2014, defendant Robinson and co-defendant Devon Scott, who were starters for the University of Dayton Men's Basketball team, were dismissed from the team. Subsequently both defendants withdrew from the University of Dayton.

On March 24, 2015 complaints and arrest warrants were filed, charging both defendants.

Defendant Robinson pled guilty by bill of information to the charges, which are fourth degree felonies. The defendant will be sentenced on July 1, 2015 at 2:00 p.m.

Defendant Scott's case remains pending.
